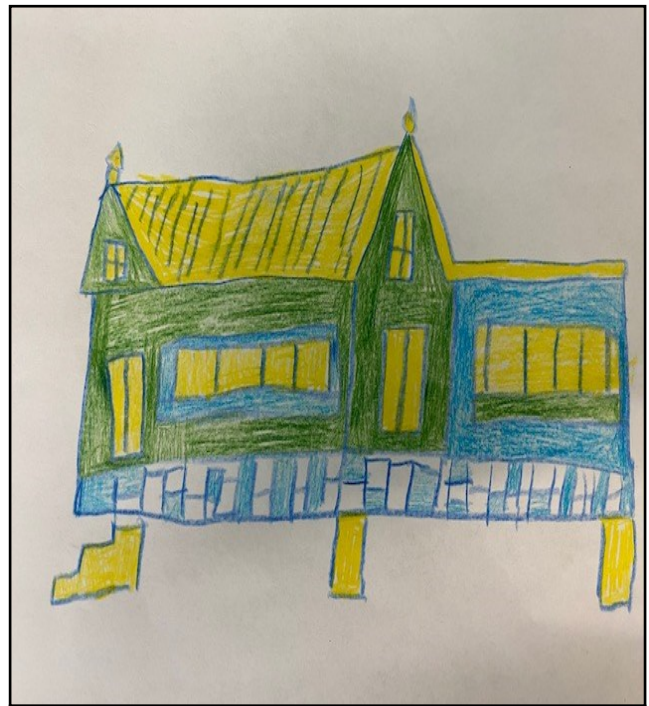
A Tour to Vietnam and Back to the United States By LG
